INFORMATION FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS

Nomination deadlines	First semester/full year: May 15th Second semester: October 15th
Application deadlines	First semester/full year: June 20th Second semester: November 20th
Period of the mobility	We accept students for one semester of the full year. Full year is recommended since practical courses last one year while theory courses last one semester.
Application process	Students are nominated by their home institution by May 15 th or October 15 th . Once the nomination is sent, students will receive information on which documents to submit to apply:

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Application form • ID • Artistic portfolio (at least 10 artworks), pdf format • Italian language certification (not compulsory)
Selection process	A committee of professors will reunite and examine students' portfolios and applications. Students will be accepted depending on the quality of their work and the places available in each department/course. Students will receive an answer within 1 month from the application deadline.
Selected students	Selected students must send their Learning Agreement to erasmus@accademiavenezia.it
Language requirements	Every year the Academy will confirm if an Italian language course will be given for the incoming students. If the course is not organized, the recommended Italian level for students is B1. An Italian language certification is not compulsory. However, students are strongly recommended to study Italian before their arrival. All the classes in the Academy are given in Italian.
Transcript of records	A Transcript of Records will be issued within four weeks after the end of the exchange period.
